



## **CampusAFRICA-2018**

### **SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT RESEARCH AWARDS**

Within the framework of objectives of the international programme CampusAFRICA, and in order to boost the scientific and sociocultural leadership of younger African generations, the Canary Islands Foundation for the Control of Tropical Diseases (FUNCCET) hereby calls for the **CampusÁFRICA-2018** sustainable development research awards, in compliance with the following provisions:

1. The awards are aimed at the recognition and support of innovative ideas or projects with potential impact on sustainable development connected with any of the objectives included in the 2030 Agenda (health, education, equality, peace, habitability, agriculture, water, energy, ecosystems, climate, etc.)
2. The candidates willing to apply, shall comply with the following requirements:
  - 2.1. Be under 35 years of age at the time of presenting their proposal.
  - 2.2. Be a national citizen of an African country and have permanent residence in Africa.
  - 2.3. Be professionally ascribed to a university or African research centre or institution and be involved in research work in the said institution.
  - 2.4. Have an adequate command of the English language.
3. All projects presented to be eligible for the awards must comply with the following requirements:
  - 3.1. All projects presented shall be written in one of the following languages: English, French, Portuguese or Spanish.
  - 3.2. The project shall not have received any funding prior to the date of presentation.
  - 3.3. The projects must not have been published by any scientific journal or publication before they are presented.
4. All projects eligible for the CampusÁFRICA Awards must include the following documents:
  - 4.1. CV of the main researcher of the project and of the other members of the team (if appropriate), indicating all contact details: phone number, email, professional address and postal address.
  - 4.2. Detailed project report.
  - 4.3. Photocopy of the passport or legal identification document as proof of professional effective involvement with an African institution (requirements included in section 2)

- 4.4. Personal statement of being in compliance with the requirements listed in section 3.
5. The project's report must include the following sections:
  - 5.1. Description of the project
  - 5.2. Objectives
  - 5.3. Innovative aspects and other aspects of interest
  - 5.4. Impact or contribution to the development of the country
  - 5.5. Planning/stages of the project's development
  - 5.6. Plan of expenses
6. All proposals presented will be examined by a jury consisting of specialists appointed by the FUNC CET and will be assessed in accordance with the criteria of novelty, feasibility, scalability, implementation plan and geographical distribution.
7. There will be two prizes awarded, each of them consisting of a prize of 3,000 euros. In addition to the financial prize, the authors of the winning proposals will be awarded a scholarship to participate in CampusÁFRICA. Each scholarship will cover travel, accommodation and maintenance expenses.
8. All winning projects will be presented by the autor(s) in the appropriate session for that purpose within the programme of CampusÁFRICA-2018.
9. The deadline to submit proposals will close next 12<sup>th</sup> April 2018.
